EARLY ACTION APPLICATION MEETINGS

Your child's academic performance in high school courses taken in 7th and/or 8th grade may make them eligible to apply for Early Action to School for Advanced Studies (SAS) at Miami Dade College (MDC) or Academy for Advanced Academics (AAA) at Florida International University (FIU). Applications for Early Action will only be accepted from students who took advanced high school classes such as Algebra 1, Geometry, Physical Science, Biology, and high school foreign language courses in 7th and/or 8th grades and earned a minimum final grade of "A" or "B". At a minimum, students must have taken and earned a credit in Algebra 1 with a grade of A or B.

Students applying through Early Action must submit an application to the corresponding SAS or AAA campus early in their 9th grade year of high school. To be considered for Early Action, a prospective applicant must have a minimum unweighted high school GPA of 3.0 at the time of application and provide proof of passing scores on the PSAT/NMSQT, PERT, or ACCUPLACER NG tests by December 1st of their 9th grade year. Applicants then would be considered for admission to SAS or AAA for their 11th and 12th grade years of high school, space permitting.

SAS/AAA will be holding two information/application meetings in the coming months.

The **first meeting** is scheduled at Miami Dade College North Campus located at 11380 NW 27th Avenue, Miami, Florida 33167, in Building 3, Second Floor Conference Center, Room 3249 on Saturday, February 10, 2024 at 10:00 am.

The **second meeting** will be held at Miami Dade College Kendall Campus located at 11011 SW 104th Street, Miami, Florida 33176, in the gym (Building 7) on Saturday, March 16, 2024 at 9:00 am.
